The collected dresses and accessories will be available at a shopping event allowing girls to try on and select their favorite dress ...all for free. A donation of \$5.00 is suggested. To "shop" for a dress, girls can come to the Arch Village Shopping Center at 9205 Midlothian Turnpike in Richmond, on Friday, April 11, 2008 from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm, Saturday, April 12, 2008 from 11:00 am to 4:00 pm and Sunday, April 13, 2008 from 1:00 pm to 3:00 pm. Girls will be helped on a first-come, first-served basis.
